**Under NHS regulations, if you opt for private treatment on any tooth requiring treatment, the root canal treatment must be charged for privately.*

The maximum charge for a patient receiving NHS treatment is £384 for a single course of treatment

All patients are eligible for NHS dental treatment at Belhaven Dental Surgery.

If you are in one of the following categories you may qualify for full or partial exemption from charges:

- Under 18
- 18 years old & in full time education
- Expectant mothers
- Have had a baby in the past 12 months
- Are receiving certain social security benefits
- Hold a valid NHS charges Certificate

If you are on a low income, we can provide an application form to apply for help with dental charges.

If you do not fall into any of the above categories you will be required to pay NHS charges.
